



HINTS FOR RECRUITING VOLUNTEERS

There are more willing volunteers than you might think. Try asking:

- ✓ High school students
Youth have the potential to be excellent volunteers. They have the energy and time to commit to the camp. They will require more direction though which is why we suggest inviting some of the youth group leaders to volunteer as well to motivate and encourage the team. Plus, they are required to volunteer a certain number of hours to graduate.
- ✓ Sunday school teachers – these are leaders children will see at church if they come!
- ✓ Bible study groups – ask a small group to volunteer
- ✓ Service clubs
- ✓ Sports associations (e.g. minor league teams)
- ✓ Parents
- ✓ Teachers
- ✓ Other local churches
- ✓ Retirees in your church

Consider inviting your youth group to take this week on as a mission trip or ministry to others. One church made the week of camp into the youth mission trip for the year. Doing this ensured the church had adequate volunteers for our camp and helped the youth realize this is more than just a camp; it is a ministry and they play an important role.
